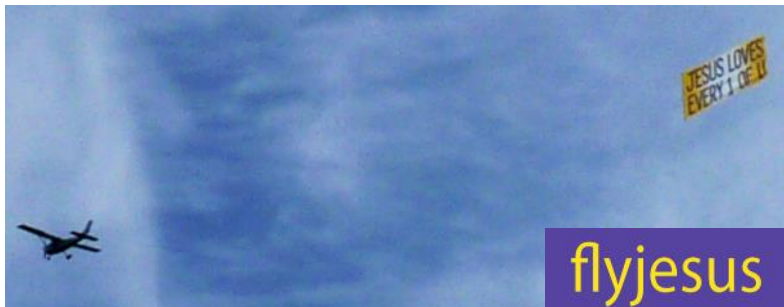
The hours we need are

Phil 4:2-9

God is concerned with what we do, what we say, and what we think.

However, what we do, say, and think is the result of the kind of attitude that characterizes our nature, temperament, or frame of mind.

In life we all experience trials and difficulties that can make us unhappy, and there is nothing wrong with feeling unhappy in such situations.
