Report to the Parish 2 February 20

Well, here we are – a week into Howard's absence and we don't appear to be coming apart at the seams! And that's because there was very careful planning months before to ensure a seamless transfer of responsibilities from Howard to each of the Teams.

Firstly, we are far from being leaderless. Though the inhouse team remain an obvious first point of contact, Rev Brian Pritchard, as Alton Area Dean, maintains his watchful spiritual and pastoral oversight of us *in loco* Howard. We shall see him more often taking Communion services so please raise with him any personal matter, bereavement etc, that cannot be handled by the inhouse team, particularly Jane and Lorna.

Technically, the Churchwardens are responsible for the church in Howard's absence. In practical terms the Wardens, the staff: Matt, Jane and Lorna and the Ministry Team leaders keep us all committed and moving forward. We meet and communicate frequently to keep each other informed. And since it clearly works, let's not even try to fix it! Matt in the office is the focal point, handling the 'flyers' and allocating them, as appropriate, to one of the Team.

The PCC remains responsible for our long-term governance but now chaired by one of the Wardens (Chris).

We shall be meeting some new faces as well as familiar ones at our Communion services. In the immediate future, Phil Collins presides on 2 February, Andrew Micklefield from the Parish of the Resurrection on 9th, and Yann Dubreuil and Ed Pruen on 23rd.

It is Howard's hope that this period of 3 months on our own would be a spur to our developing our individual vocations and talents. Let us all commit to do that so we can hand the parish back to Howard even more committed to the Kingdom than when he left it.

Small Group Notes – 2nd February 2020 Gifted – Gifts of the Spirit

Bible readings: 1Corithians 12:1-11 John 16:7-15

1) What spiritual gifts do you see being used in our Church?

2) Share how you became aware of your own gifting. 3) How do you use your gifts - to build up your faith? for the church?, outside the church in everyday life? Can you give examples of how the gifts are used in these areas, from your own experience or from others?

4)How do you feel when you are using or seeing a gift being used?

5)Are there gifts you would like to have to help you in church life? The passage tells us to desire the gifts. Discuss what these gifts would be and take time in your small group to pray for each other.

6) Paul suggests that we should all desire the gift of prophecy. How do you as a group feel about this gift? Share your experiences. If you would like to practice and exercise this gift, listen to a worship song or psalm together than ask god in prayer to open your eyes and hearts to hear from him. Share what you believe God has given you. This may be something you have never done before, taking a risk, remember we have a God of love and humility.
