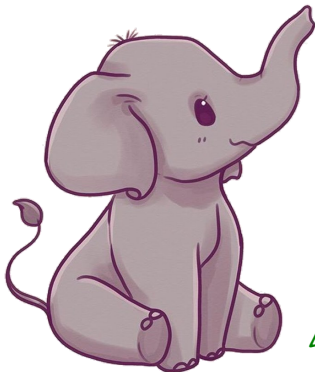
Given the current coronavirus restrictions, the funeral is of course strictly limited on numbers for attendance.
