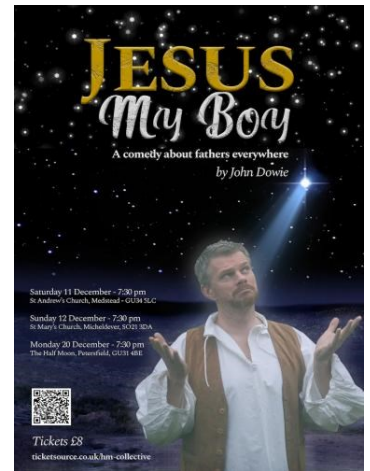
## Help with Transport

## Our Escape Rooms are back!

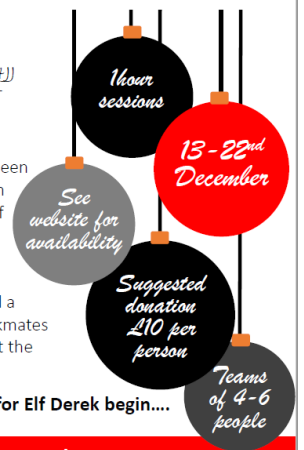
